2010 BUDGET

The Public Hearing on the 2010 Town of Claverack was held at the Town Hall, Rte. #217, Mellenville, Columbia County, New York.

Supervisor Keegan gave overview on the 2010 Budget:

\$23,200.00 was revised for the Comprehensive Committee to \$15,000.00, with explanation from Town Attorney, Robert Fitzsimmons, Esq.

The Ambulance Services were increased by 10 percent, which is a chargeback by the County. The figures are \$21,000.00 for Philmont and Greenport. Copake has been added and will get \$1,000.00. Philmont requested \$70,550.00 for this coming year. Some discussion on County Rescue Squad.

Revenues are down.

Decision made to include a Town-wide reassessment GAR Associates has been contacted for prices. This firm has been used by other Towns in the County.

New York State Retirement not settled – significant change for coming year.

Records Management cut by Governor.

Health benefits improved Co-payments remain same – members do not have to change doctors. Co-pay on prescriptions no longer \$100.00 deductible. No increase in contribution by participants.

Highway cut last year. Three State of Emergencies – No reimbursement for July or August storms.

Sales Tax and Mortgage Tax down.
