A public hearing on the 2013 Town Budget was held at the Town Office Building, 91 Church Street, Mellenville, New York, beginning at 7:00 P.M.

Hearing called to order by Deputy Supervisor, Robert Preusser, who led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Discussion on the proposed budget figures – Board went over figures together. Present increase 1.55 percent. Memo from Supervisor thought that I could be brought down to less than 1 percent to around .85%. Councilman Johnston was pleased with the 1.55%, but thought that 1.85 % would give a cushion for any unforeseen problems during 2013.

All employees will receive a 3% raise, excluding Town Board members, Cleaner, Dog Control Officer. Request from Town Court judges for a change from part-time to fulltime position in court office personnel. This will be discussed in executive session.

Motion by Councilman Preusser, seconded by Councilman Johnston to into Executive Session to discuss Personnel at 7:40 p.m. Carried.

Motion by Councilman Johnston, seconded by Councilman Preusser to go out of Executive Session at 8:00 p.m. Carried.

Since Supervisor was then present, discussion continued on the 2013 proposed budget.
